School Materials/Fees:

The school will be open to parents on Tuesday, August 21st from 10:30am – 3:00pm, Wednesday August 22nd, from 11:30a.m. – 6:00p.m. and Thursday, August 23rd, from 10:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., in order to purchase your children's workbooks and agendas and to pay their school fees in full, payable in cash or by debit or credit card. The exact amount to be paid will be posted on our website prior to the days of purchases. **NO AGENDA OR WORKBOOK** will be distributed in class on the first day of school. Parents must come the school and pick them up. If you are unable to attend any of those three days, you will receive an invoice on the first day of school and the agenda and workbooks will be sent home once we receive payment. DRESS CODE:

Twin Oaks has an established dress code in place. This consists of navy blue bottoms (no jeans) with a white or burgundy top dress code.
