- **Auditions will be held on October 21st for Grades 3-6 and Sec 1-5**
- **Choir rehearsals will be every Saturday from 2-3pm at Laval Junior Academy from October 27, 2018 to March 23, 2019**
- **The students who are chosen will be charged a registration fee of \$100 payable to ATELIER MUSICAL PANARMONIA and their parents will sign a waiver of intellectual rights as well as a media release since the children will be featured in many mass media.**

The students do not need to prepare for the audition. They just bring their singing voices!



Students will:

- participate in a unique musical experience, to rehearse, perform and record alongside a 40-piece symphonic orchestra in world-class venues: an opportunity availed to few;
- take a voyage to the world of music production and learn how a professional CD is made - from recording to final mixing, editing and mastering, led by Juno Award winning judge Dr. Mark Corwin;
- learn the value and rewards that come from hard work and discipline;
- grow their self-esteem knowing they are part of a prestigious and successful international project;
- practice teamwork and cooperation with their peers from other schools;
- experience not just the excitement, but also the dedication needed to be a professional recording artist.
