The SWLSB Council of Commissioners approved our Commitment to Success Plan in October 2018, which was subsequently approved by the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur in November 2018. To be aligned with this plan, **TWIN OAKS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** developed our Educational Project which was adopted by the **TWIN OAKS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** Governing Board on **May 21, 2019**. As did all schools in Quebec, we began implementation of this project during the 2019-2020 school year.
