Students in Cycle 3 will be evaluated in the following subjects. All evaluation takes place over three terms. Each subject includes from one to three competencies. The value of the grades for each term is weighted the same for all subjects: Term 1-20%, Term 2-20%, and Term 3-60%. The Competencies for each subject are weighted depending on the number and importance of the competencies.
