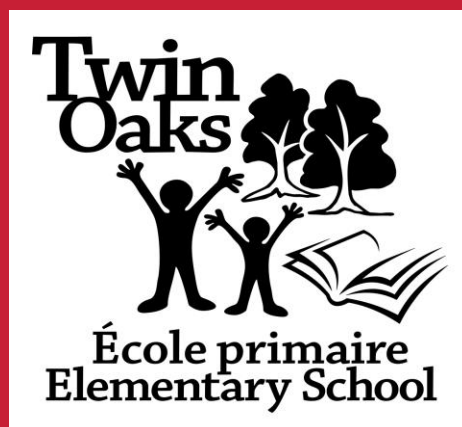

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2020-2021 EMERGENCY PROTOCOL

In response to the possibility of a second wave of COVID-19 that would require the closure of Twin Oaks Elementary School OR the closure of a classroom, this Emergency Protocol is our contingency plan which outlines all the key actions to be implemented and elements to be considered to ensure continuity of learning for all students.

This plan is intended to provide all stakeholders with a list of elements that we will consider to react quickly, that may result from a new state of emergency. It allows for the planning of additional actions beyond the measures already implemented in accordance with guidelines from the public health authorities.

Twin Oaks will be using **T.O.E.S WEBNODE ONLINE PLATFORM** as the main communication platform for all parents to connect with their child's teachers. All communications coming from the school administration will be sent through mass e-mail from the desk of spotamoussis@swlauriersb.qc.ca

The resource team and attendants, in collaboration with the classroom teachers, will continue to provide the regularly scheduled classroom support to their assigned students.

In addition, the resource teachers will communicate their weekly availability to respond to student's needs **as per the MEES chart above.**

SUPPORT WITH REGARD TO MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL BEING

In order to support student wellness, homeroom teachers will schedule one block per week dedicated to providing students with an opportunity to share their feelings and concerns with their classmates and teachers. This, in turn, will allow teachers to identify students who may need additional professional support.

The physical education team will offer opportunities for students to move and use different strategies in order to develop and maintain a healthy balance of mental, social/emotional and physical well-being.

In collaboration with our in-school special education technician, students who require social and emotional support will have access to Ms. Jenny who will be available during school hours by reaching out to her directly at jgalvano@swlauriersb.qc.ca.

In collaboration with our social dance teacher, Ms. Sarah-Maude will provide online video opportunities for social dancing, as offered for our pre-K and Kindergarten students this year.

TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES

In collaboration with the parent community, Twin Oaks has submitted the names of all students requiring a device to support distance learning to the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board's IT department. In the event of a shutdown, technological support will be distributed in a timely manner.

ONE online communication platform-T.O.E.S WEBNODE allows for all parents and students to access their teacher's homework assignments, teaching material, and preferred online method of communication. **T.O.E.S WEBNODE** is easily accessible on our Twin Oaks Webpage.

Teachers will provide an online schedule for their parents through webnode for immediate access should teaching transition to distance learning.

Teachers will continue using online teaching tools to facilitate transition to distance learning (IXL, Raz-Kids, Language Nut, Alphabetik etc.)
